Day 3: B, L, D

This morning we'll hit the ground running – literally. After breakfast, we'll have a **training session**. Your coaches will lead the training; pitch and balls will be provided.

In the afternoon, we'll make our way to watch a **professional football game**. Lazio and Roma are the two principal football teams of Rome. They both have large local followings – dividing the city in two – and play in Serie A, Italy's top division. The two teams share the Stadio Olimpico and alternate its use. The derby matches between the two teams are hugely important, with an electric atmosphere which spreads through the whole city.

Please also know that if one of the top team matches may not be possible, we will give you every option possibility that will correspond with your dates of travel. Also understand that summer is the off-season for Italian soccer. If your trip falls in June-August, professional games may not be available.

Day 4: B, L, D

Today will be **FRIENDLY MATCH 1**. Game times will vary based on competition availability and time of year for travel. Both boys and girls teams are welcome.

When not playing, we'll also delve into **Ancient Rome** today with a guided tour. Discover the **Roman Coliseum**, the **Roman Forum**, **Fori Imperiali** and more.

After dinner this evening, we'll learn about the **Roman Gladiators**. Participants will be able to visit the **Gladiator School** for a full training session plus check-out the **Gladiator Museum**.

EXCURSION OPTION: Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel & St Peter's Basilica

Discover the Vatican with a tour of the Sistine Chapel and the Vatican Museums. Navigate the vast complex of rooms, artwork, and history with a guide who brings the ancient collection to life. Explore halls such as the **Gallery of the Maps**, step inside the **Sistine Chapel** to admire 'The Creation of Adam' by Michelangelo and finish your tour visiting **St. Peter's Basilica**. This experience is simply amazing and one of the most beautiful sites in the world!

Day 5: B, L, D

This morning we'll kick off with a **Professional Coaching Session**. Meet your **Italian Coaching Team** and blend your coaching skills to offer an amazing morning of skill development and training techniques.

It is considered by many academics to have been the **birthplace of the Renaissance**, becoming a major artistic, cultural, commercial, political, economic and financial center.

EXCURSION OPTION: The Galleria dell 'Accademia di Firenze

Among the greatest sculptural masterpieces ever chiseled by human hands, **Michelangelo's David** needs no introduction. Its combination of ideal beauty and strength of spirit crowns Florence's Accademia Gallery. Visit this world-famous museum and learn about the impressive collection of artwork inside. Witness Michelangelo's masterpiece and hear about its fascinating history. You'll also have a chance to check out the artist's unfinished "Prigioni" as well as works by Renaissance greats like Lippi and Botticelli.

Day 7: B, L, D

After breakfast this morning we'll transfer to Milan. On arrival, we'll tour the **Mondo Milan Museum**. From its origins as **Milan Football & Cricket Club** to the pinnacle of world football: relive over 120 years of Rossoneri history told through this spectacular collection of memorabilia, victories and exclusive interviews to guide you through the Rossoneri's glorious history. Memories and testimonies are interspersed with the artifacts that made history, in a true emotional crescendo.

This afternoon we'll enjoy a Milan Professional Football Game.

Also known as the **Giuseppe Meazza Stadium** and named after the legendary Italian footballer, this iconic sporting arena has not only witnessed some of the most legendary football matches but has also become an integral part of the cultural fabric of Milan.

This evening we'll try our hand at culinary culture with a pasta or pizza making class for dinner.

On our last full day in Italy we'll start by getting to know the city with a Milan Guided City Tour. We'll make sure you have time for shopping and exploration too!

In the afternoon we'll visit **Casa Milan**, the **AC Milan Headquarters**. Explore the Museum, shop the store and soak in the vibes! Since May 2014, the Rossoneri have had a modern and functional headquarters: Casa Milan. It welcomes Rossoneri fans and all those who want to learn about their history and values.

This evening we'll have our Farewell Dinner as we start to say goodbye to Italy and wrap up with a fun night **bowling!**
