Day 1

Dinner on arrival, contingent upon arrival time

Travel to Florida arriving in St. Augustine in the afternoon. After check-in, we'll have our Welcome, Safety & Orientation meeting and get settled in.

S1. Augustine - Founded in 1565, St. Augustine is the oldest continuously occupied settlement of European and African-American origin in the United States. Forty-two years before the English colonized Jamestown and fifty-five years before the Pilgrims landed at Plymouth Rock, the Spanish established at St. Augustine this nation's first enduring settlement. Sample Hotel: Guy Harvey Beach Resort - Guy Harvey Resort is located directly on St. Augustine Beach with easy access to the sand and surf via an outdoor pool deck. The 153-room resort features spectacular ocean views, an outdoor pool & tiki bar, beach chair and board rentals and loads of Guy Harvey apparel available in the gift shop. Rooms include a flat screen television, refrigerator, and a spacious work desk. Resort amenities include complimentary Wi-Fi, fitness center, and digital business center. Guest rooms feature two queen beds to sleep up to four pupils per room; staff sleep single or double occupancy. Breakfast is served in the hotel restaurant.







After getting settled in, we'll set off to spend our first Florida afternoon in search of dolphins!

Dolphin & Wildlife Adventure Tour - Enjoy the wetlands, coastal marshes, and wildlife while being guided by marine naturalists. The St. Augustine area is beaming with estuary delights and home to a plethora of wildlife, including birds, dolphins, manatees, turtles, and much more. Dolphins are seen here year-round and call this bay their home. On tour, guests regularly witness all types of behaviors like playing, hunting, breeding, and caring for their young.



This evening we'll have a Welcome Dinner locally to kick off our tour.

Breakfast & dinner included; lunch on own

Good morning St Augustine! After breakfast, we have a very full day today. Starting with a city tour and ending with a beach master class on sea turtles!

St. Augustine City Tour - St. Augustine is among the oldest cities in the country and this immersive walking tour offers the perfect opportunity to learn about its rich past. Meet your guide downtown and set off on foot. Stroll down the beautiful streets and you'll discover highlights like the Castillo de San Marcos National Monument, Huguenot Cemetery, Bridge of Lions and more. You'll hear stories covering more than 300 years of St. Augustine history, see many of St. Augustine's top landmarks, and enjoy a brilliant day learning about the Spanish, the British, the Flagler's and more.



Castillo de San Marcos National Monument - The oldest masonry fort in the continental United States, the Castillo de San Marcos is a large Spanish stone fortress built to protect and defend Spain's claims in the New World. Construction began on the Castillo de San Marcos in 1672 and lasted 23 years, until 1695. The fort came under fire for the first time in 1702. British forces, led by General Moore, burned the city but could not penetrate the Castillo's walls. Subsequent attacks in 1728 and 1740 yielded similar results, and the British were never able to take the city of St. Augustine by force. In 1763 however, Florida became a British colony, thus beginning a 20-year period of English rule. The Castillo was used as a military prison during the Revolutionary War, and at one time it held three signers of the Declaration of Independence within its walls.






At the end of the Revolutionary War, Florida was returned to Spain in 1784 until Florida became a United States Territory in 1821. The U.S. Government used the fort as a prison for Native Americans in the late 1800s. Natives from both Florida and the Great Plains were held at the fort during this time. The fort was officially taken off the active list of fortifications in 1900 and it was preserved and recognized as a National Monument in 1924.

Ponce de Leon's Fountain of Youth Archaeological Park - Visit the park for a fascinating, informative, entertaining tour of Ponce de Leon's Fountain of Youth Archaeological Park, the original site of the Nation's oldest city. Located in the area first explored by Juan Ponce de Leon in 1513 and settled by Pedro Menendez de Aviles in 1565, historic St. Augustine is the oldest successful European settlement in the United States. Colonial America started right here, 55 years before the Pilgrims landed on Plymouth Rock, and 42 years before Jamestown! With a long, rich history spanning nearly 500 years, the Fountain of Youth Park will delight and amaze you. The park includes 15 waterfront acres.







After getting settled in, we'll head to the beach for a special presentation by St. John's County.

The Beach Turtles of St John's County – Get educated on sea turtles with a beach Turtle Master Class provided by the county's conservation team. The beaches of St. Johns County are the area's largest natural resource consisting of 41.1 miles of various sandy conditions. From coquina to soft white sand, these beaches host a variety of coastal wildlife including several species of endangered or threatened sea turtles, the native Anastasia Island beach mice, gopher tortoises, and shorebirds. Each spring the beaches are buzzing with activity as wildlife use the beaches and dunes for nesting and foraging that continues throughout the summer months. Sea turtle nesting season is from May 1 - October 31.

This evening we'll have dinner at our hotel. Afterwards, let's grab our headlamps for a crab safari!

Day 3

Breakfast & dinner included; lunch on own

Hello Florida! After breakfast, we'll load up and travel to Port Canaveral, approximately a 2-hour drive. On arrival, we'll check out the Port Canaveral Exploration Tower and then spend the rest of the day in Florida's brilliant sunshine!

Port Canaveral Exploration Tower - Located along the East Coast of Florida, Exploration Tower is an architectural landmark providing both fun and education. Learn about Port Canaveral's history, enjoy panoramic views of Port Canaveral and Kennedy Space Center, and wave goodbye to cruise ships as they pass by on the way out to sea. With seven floors of exhibits and interactive play, Exploration Tower includes something for everyone. Guests have access to both indoor and outdoor observation decks with nearly 5,550 feet of exhibit space and more.

Later, we'll check into our Cocoa Beach hotel and then have fun time in the resort and on the beach! We'll probably want to get in a stop at **Ron Jon Surf Shop's** flagship store. Dinner will be served at the hotel this evening.

Rise and shine for a spectacular space day! This morning we'll check out of our hotel and head to NASA's Kennedy Space Center.

NASA's Kennedy Space Center - John Glenn, Neil Armstrong, Sally Ride and Jim Lovell are just a few names of the brave men and women that have launched into space from Kennedy Space Center. Your day of exploration includes real space hardware, authentic attractions, inspiring exhibits and hands-on experiences. The incredible accomplishments of the Apollo moon program return to life in the amazing Apollo/Saturn V Center. In back-to-back IMAX® theatres, you'll feel the thrill of space exploration as you "float" right alongside NASA Astronauts. On guided tours into exclusive areas, you'll get a behind-the-scenes look at Kennedy Space Center's working space flight facilities. Strap in and experience interactive space flight simulators at the Astronaut Hall of Fame. Touch a real piece of Mars, see gigantic rockets, board the Space Shuttle Explorer and much more.



Your exploration of Kennedy Space Center starts with one of their world-renowned tours, where you depart the Visitor Complex to see awesome NASA facilities, including the massive launch pads, gigantic Vehicle Assembly Building, and exploring the awe-inspiring Apollo/Saturn V Center. There is much to do at the Visitor Complex when you return, from live action theatrical shows to an inspiring Astronaut Encounter with one of the few





people on Earth who have been to space. View ten-story high rockets from all eras of space exploration in the Rocket Garden, walk through a full-size Space Shuttle mock-up, see IMAX space films on gigantic five-story screens, and see an actual Gemini program capsule on display in Early Space Exploration.

After our full day at Kennedy Space Center, we'll travel to Orlando, check into our new hotel and have dinner locally.
